## PROTOCOL FOR BOAT DOCK ASSIGNMENTS

1. The waiting list is maintained by Karen Ewart only. Only paid members can request to be on the waiting list.
2. Members already on the water requesting moves get moved first, as their requests can be accommodated. (Example: Member in back bay wants Promenade and a Promenade dock opens up, the member would then be moved.) Members requesting a particular dock number would be moved first, if that space will accommodate their boat. Most new boats are 8'6" wide and some docks will not accept this width. And, historically we try to place sailboats in a location where a u-turn is not necessary to access their slip.
3. Once all the members already in the water have been moved and their requests accommodated, the next priority to fill is those requests from land storage members and then the waiting list.
4. The waiting list is filled in order of the date officially requested and as dock and boat size is accommodated.
5. Members are not allowed to trade docks among themselves. It gives an unfair advantage to those who have been on the waiting list as well as causes confusion in billing and "in case of emergency" notifications.
6. If a club member is not delinquent in dues, assessments, or charges, his assigned dock cannot be changed without written permission of that member.
