

## **Boat Club Annual Meeting**

On Saturday, September 1<sup>st</sup>, the Casper Boat Club Annual Meeting was held. Over sixty members were in attendance to hear the Board report on the status of the club. Treasurer John Hatcher reported that the club is in good financial standings and has over one hundred thousand dollars that can be used for future repairs, upgrades and club operation expenses.

Dave McMahan explained all of the upgrades that have been done to the clubhouse. A new commercial hot water heater was installed; a new soft drink bar was added to the kitchen area to relieve pressure on the bar. A new automatic sliding door was installed between the patio and restaurant. Dave also thanked Win Farnsworth for donating a new computer billing system for the club, as well as providing all the training for system implementation.

Jon Dannels thanked all the members for their participation and donations at the annual Poker Run. This year the event raised over \$45,000 for the Jason's Friends Foundation.

Ken Hampton talked about the repairs and upgrades to the docks. All Back Bay docks were rhino lined and will get a second coat this fall. Over five thousand tons of dirt was removed from the Back Bay to allow members to navigate the shallow tight corner going into the Back Bay docks. He thanked Lynn Burgess for all the welding and repairs that have been done to many docks due to strong easterly storms.

Mary Ann Hoff gave an overview of all the work that has taken place on the grounds. New signs, tree trimming and basic repairs have been ongoing. Nancy Brown also thanked the members for all their participation in the many fun events held at the club throughout the summer.

The Board recognized and thanked Sonya Gruner for her many years of Board service. Nancy Means and Patrick Elbogen were the two newly elected Board members. Dave McMahan will be the new Commodore and John Hatcher will serve as Vice Commodore. Ken Hampton is the treasurer and Paulette Hahn will serve as secretary.
