## REMINDERS:

Due to new regulations, there can be NO work done on any dock without the Board obtaining a permit from BLM. If you have plans to work on your dock, you MUST contact the Board FIRST, and we will apply for a permit. Our lease with BLM depends on compliance of their rules.

## Food/Bar Assessment: Effective May-August

You must spend \$75 in food and bar, excludes sales tax and gratuity, or you will be assessed the difference.

## Annual Dues:

Regular Resident \$400.00  
Regular Non-resident \$450.00  
Commercial \$600.00  
Senior (Over 65) \$200.00  
Junior (18-25) \$250.00

*Dues increase of \$50 was presented by the Board of Directors at the Annual meeting.*

*There was also an assessment of \$100 for the 2018 season that will be billed and due by March 1, 2018. The assessment is for the beginning phases of rebuilding the bulkhead. The costs to complete the project are estimated to be around \$250,000.*
