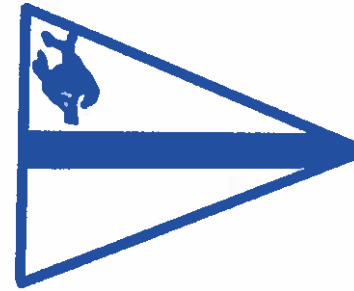

You must spend \$75 in food & bar, excludes sales tax & gratuity, or you will be assessed the difference.

ANNUAL DUES:

Regular Resident \$400.00
Regular Non-resident \$450.00
Commercial \$600.00
Senior (Over 65) \$200.00
Junior (18-25) \$250.00

Dues increase of \$50 was presented by the Board of Directors at the Annual meeting.

There was also an assessment of \$100 for the 2018 season that will be billed to all new & renewing members. The assessment is for the beginning phases of rebuilding the bulkhead. The costs to complete the project are estimated to be around \$250,000.
